

Instructions for completing the **study plan (MSc programs)**:

General note:

The information provided for planning future semesters (at TUM or abroad) is preliminary and not binding. In particular, the selection of courses abroad depends on the specific offerings for each semester and often cannot be reliably planned far in advance. The study plan aims to provide an initial structured and feasible outline for the further course of study, including the stay abroad.

Study Progress at TUM

By completing this section, we should get a clear overview of your academic progress so far and what you plan to finish before your stay abroad. This helps us understand your study timeline.

- Fill out a table for each semester completed or planned before your stay abroad, including the current and future semesters.
- List all modules you have passed for previous semesters. Use extra lines at the end if needed.
- For current and future semesters, list the modules you plan to take at TUM.
- If you will have studied more than four semesters before your stay abroad, use the additional lines to outline your full course plan.
- For the stay abroad: Select “Semester abroad” from the drop-down menu and leave the table blank. You will enter the courses at the host university later in the section “Preliminary course selection abroad.”

Preliminary Course Selection Abroad

In this section, you show that you have already reviewed the courses offered by your preferred universities.

- Complete a table for each university you are applying to via MoveOn.
- Your course selection abroad must include **at least 20 ECTS per semester**, of which **at least 10 ECTS must be related to informatics**.
- In the column “Planned type of recognition,” please indicate how you intend to have the module recognized [options: *1:1 Recognition* (equivalence with a TUM module), *Recognition as Elective*, or *Recognition as Support Elective* (ÜfG)]. If no recognition is planned, enter “None.” Add individual comments if necessary.

- This is to make it clear that you have already thought about recognition. Your information is not binding, as recognition will only be reviewed individually and bindingly after your stay abroad. Furthermore, there is no obligation for you to have credits from abroad recognized at TUM.
