Inbound Exchange Program	Students enrolled (or matriculated) at partner institutions and are nominated by their home institutions.	A nomination link will be emailed to the partner institutions' coordinator(s) in every nomination period.
Inbound Visiting Program (Fee-Paying Exchange Program)	 Students enrolled at partner institutions but not officially nominated. Students from non-partner institutions. 	Students apply directly via the online application system in the application period.






Eligibility




Inbound exchange students enrolled in our partner institutions across Europe.

**Resident from Mainland China, Hong Kong and Macau are ineligible for the scholarship.





- Recipients will receive a monthly stipend for a minimum of NTD15,000 for four months. (The exact amount of the scholarship will be subject to adjustment by NYCU.)
- During the exchange period, expenses such as accommodation, facility, and other necessary fees are at the student's own expense.





- Please nominate the students via email (directly to the NYCU coordinator)
 during the online nomination period.
- Since the scholarship spots are adjusted by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs each semester, the final confirmation will be announced along with the admission results.
