Mandatory for all Informatic
Master students

Worth: 16 credits

Recommendation: do it in 2nd or 3rd semester

Important to know cont'd

IDP consists of two parts

- a lecture (min 5 ECTS, from department of the supervisor, may not be on list of elective modules from master's informatics, no seminar, lab course, may be a bachelor's module)
- the project itself

Grading:

- 30 % lecture grade
- 70 % project grade

The project may be done in cooperation with

- a department of the university
- a company (e.g. a spin-off)

The supervisor must be a professor

- from another department than Informatics or
- from the department of Informatics with an affiliate membership in another department https://www.in.tum.de/en/the-department/people-chairs/affiliate-membership/

Note

Due to the fact that the IDP is part of the master's examination, the supervisor must be an officially appointed examiner for the application subject. Should the supervisor not be appointed, special

Tips

Register in time – approval process takes about 1 month

Once approved it shows in your TUMOnline account

After approval lecture **cannot** be changed

IDP can be passed even if the lecture was not

In case you fail the exam for the lecture it can be repeated **once** (!)

Tips cont'd

IPDs in cooperation with companies

- The official supervisor of the IDP must always meet the criteria outlined above
- Promising, if the supervisors are somehow connected to the company, e.g., spin-off
- Very difficult if only you have the contact –
 why should the supervisor have an interest?
- Most important: Everyone involved (supervisor, advisor, company contact, student(s)) should meet (at least) once in person to make sure everybody is on the same page.

- LMU
- Contact potential advisors directly, who might know you from previous experiences

How to successfully master an IDP?

- Keep close contact to your advisor
- Adhere to milestones and project plan
