You have to submit all documents in digital form via TUMonline<sup>1</sup>. Please do not send any hard-copies via post. Especially do not send original documents, since we will not return them to you.

## **Application Checklist**

☐ Statement of purpose/Motivation letter — see template
☐ (optional) Two letters of recommendation — see template
uni-assist (for non-German university)
☐ Curriculum vitae (one or two pages)
<ul> <li>□ Bachelor, master, or diploma degree, together with:</li> <li>□ certified copy of university transcripts</li> <li>□ translation (if documents are not in German or in English)</li> <li>□ Analysis of the Curriculum — see form</li> <li>□ (optional) ranking list</li> <li>□ (optional) description of the grading system</li> </ul>
☐ TOEFL/IELTS/CAE/CPE language test score report or equivalent
(optional) proof of German proficiency
<ul> <li>Additional documents are required for applicants from some countries<sup>2</sup></li> <li>Bangladesh, China, India, Iran, Pakistan: scores of the GRE General test (or the Indian GATE)</li> <li>China, India, Vietnam: APS certificate</li> </ul>
(optional) University entrance qualification (including translation)

## **Schedule**

March 31st: Soft/recommended deadline for early (especially international) applications

April – September: Possible telephone/Zoom/BBB interview for those who've submitted their documents

until end of March

May 31st: Final deadline for all applications

July/August: Apply for student visa (as soon as possible!)

October: Enrollment

mid October: First day of class
